

Yearly report Sweden 2021/2022

Even this season the pandemic has played a negative role in the life of veteran fencers in Sweden, as well as in all other groups of persons and we are still living with the aftermath of it. With no competitions and no camps for veteran-fencers after September it seems like a lot of fencers took a break from the sport and unfortunately very few registered for the two veteran-competitions that have been held since the restrictions got reduced and classes have due that been cancelled. However, the fencers that have had the wish and possibility to train have attended senior-classes instead, quite a few with very good results.

Because of above it would not be accurate to count veteran-fencers in paid licences this year. We intend to leave a more secure report about that next year.

The official veteran committee with connections to the national board that was created 2 years ago has had some digital discussions but not had the opportunity to meet in persons. We intend to do that this coming summer and have the intention to, among other things, improve the ranking-system.

Pia Björk, from the national board, will this year represent Sweden at the EVF Congress for the first time.
