VETERANS IRISH OPEN 2025

Date: 21 - 22 June 2025

Venue: UCD Sport Center, Belfield, Dublin 4

Events: Men's and Women's foil, épée, sabre (V0, V1, V2, V3, V4)
Category "0" – fencers aged 30-39
Category "1" – fencers aged 40-49
Category "2" – fencers aged 50-59
Category "3" – fencers aged 60-69
Category "4" – fencers aged 70+

Note:

The age of the fencer at the end of the year of the season ends determines whether a fencer belongs to a specific age category (for example if the fencer was born in December 1995, they can still can fence in the event in June 2025 in category "0").

Schedule:

21 Jun 2025 Saturday Epee: Check-In closes 9.00

22 Jun 2025 Sunday, Foil: Check-In closes 10.00

22 Jun 2025 Sunday, Sabre: Check-In closes 12.00

Starting time of the events may change depending on the number of entries!





Entry fees and Deadlines

One weapon - €40
Two weapons - €60

Maximum one weapon per fencer per day.
Normal entry closes at midnight on Friday, June 6th

Late entry is possible with a €20 surcharge up until midnight on Monday, June 16th.
No entries will be accepted after this time.
Entries on spot will not be accepted!

Equipment:

Mask: 1600 N (meeting all FIE requirements in effect)

Chest protectors in foil and in épée are recommended for both for men and women.

Clothes: Breeches and Jackets at least 350 N, 800 N is recommended.

Underplastron of 800 N is obligatory.

National logo and name on the back is recommended but not compulsory.

Fencers are responsible for the good condition of their equipment.

Weapon Control:

Referees will check the equipment on the pistes. Organizers have the right to disqualify fencers that do not have proper equipment.

Miscellaneous:

The organizers are not responsible for the items or equipment lost or left unattended in the building or in the changing rooms.

There are water fountains and vending machines at the venue.
