EVF Circuit Competition in Foil, Epee, Sabre



Venue:	Guildford Spectrum Parkway Guildford GU1 1UP Just 30 minutes train journey from the centre of London, with direct train service from Gatwick airport.
Provisional Timetable:	Epee: Saturday 10th January 2026 Men's and Women's Epee 1 & 2* check-in closes 08.00, on piste by 08.15 for checks, fencing starts at 08.30. Men's Epee 3 & 4 check-in closes 13.00, on piste by 13.15 for checks, fencing starts at 13.30. Women's Epee 3 & 4 check in closes 13.15, on piste by 13.30 for checks, fencing starts at 13.45. Foil and Sabre: Sunday 11th January 2026 Men's and Women's Foil 1 & 2* check in closes 08.30, on piste by 08.45 for checks, fencing starts at 09.00. Men's and Women's Sabre 3 & 4* check in closes 09.00, fencing starts at 09.30. Men's and Women's Foil 3 & 4 check in closes 13.00, on piste by 13.15 for checks, fencing starts at 13.30 Men's Sabre 1 & 2 check in closes 13.00, fencing starts at 13.30. Women's Sabre 1 & 2 check in closes 13.15, fencing starts at 13.45 Only when entry numbers are known, will the timetable for the events be confirmed. However the day for the events will be unchanged. *be aware that hotel breakfasts are usually served at 07.30, so you may have to make your own arrangements to eat early.
Presentations:	Saturday: Medal ceremonies will take place at approximately 13.00 and from 18.00 after the finals. Sunday: Medal ceremonies will take place at approximately 12.30 and from 17.00 after the finals.
Format:	One round of pools in age groups (unless less than 12 in an age group) followed by DE in Age Groups. See EVF Circuit guidelines for details. The competition will run on 20 pistes. Depending on the number of entries, it may not be possible for fencers to compete at Foil and Sabre in all categories.
Entry Fee:	One weapon: £45 Two weapons: £75 Three weapons: £90
Entry	Entry will be online at www.veterans-fencing.co.uk
Refunds:	Refunds will be given to fencers withdrawing before 31 December, but will be subject to an administration fee.
Participants:	Open to all fencers with a valid national licence. Fencers from Russia and Belarus will not be allowed to compete according to EVF rules.
Age:	Must be 40 years or over by 31/12/2026
Equipment:	Must conform to FIE rules. Names and patches are not necessary.

Referees: Provided by the organisers.

Equipment Stand: Leon Paul will be providing an equipment stand at the event.

Armoury: There will be an armoury service available.

Closing Date: 1 January 2026. Later entries may be accepted at the organisers' discretion.
If you are applying for late entry, do not book any travel or accommodation until your entry has been confirmed.
